#### OLD BUSINESS:

**Request for additional light on utility pole in front of 14 Shattuck Street** TABLE  
guidance from DPW on standards.

**Request to address No Parking Signs on Morency Street**

TABLE pending research; when Board of Selectmen voted on “NO PARKING”, when were NO PARKING signs erected, Vote on “ACCEPTED WAY”, Chief Hicks to consult with Deputy Town Administrator.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

**DPW Director to present Final Draft of Prioritization Plan for Complete Streets Projects**

**Resident Request to Address Traffic Pattern at Pleasant Street South and Eliot Street**

Request to turn left lane at intersection of Pleasant Street South and Eliot Street to Left turn only lane and right lane to straight or right turn only. (Attachment 1)

**Resident Request to add a painted crosswalk at Woodland and Cottage Streets**

(Attachment 2) Request to add a painted crosswalk in the road from Woodland to Cottage sidewalks to alert motorists to pedestrians crossing.

**Committee Request to Remove NO RIGHT TURN ON RED sign at intersection of Oak Street and Bacon Street**

Request to remove No Right on Red sign from Oak Street south turning onto Bacon Street in a westerly direction.

**Request to add “SLOW CHILDREN AT PLAY sign at Dead End side of Bacon Street**

(Attachment 3) Request to install a “CHILDREN at PLAY” on dead end side of Bacon Street sign in an effort to slow motorists down.

**Resident Request to add a street light at end of New Hampshire** (Attachment 4)

Request to add a light on an existing pole on the Route 9 end of New Hampshire Avenue. Resident also requests street sign coming onto New Hampshire Avenue from Connecticut Ave be moved as the current sign is obstructed by evergreens.

**Resident Request to add a crosswalk at end of Lake Street connecting to the sidewalk along Route 27**

**Resident Request for crosswalk at Point Street and Pond Street with curb cutaway on Pond Street directly across from Point Street.** Request to add a crosswalk to allow residents to safely cross Pond Street in order to access sidewalk on opposite side of Pond Street.
