Request for solar LED Crossing sign be installed on Bacon Street in area of flag pole at Lilja School. Committee VOTED TO TAKE NO ACTION

OLD BUSINESS:

Citizens Request for traffic calming measures on Main Street in downtown Natick TABLE pending MAPC survey result tabulation. Natick Center Study Presentation can be found on the following website: <http://www.mapc.org/natickcenterplan>

Request for approval of MUTCD standard way finding signage to Natick Community Farm and Mass Audubon (white on brown) to be installed: TABLE pending by-law review bylaw finalized in draft form will be on Spring Town Meeting.

Resident request to address use of new parking spaces at Cole Recreation center by commuters. Committee VOTED to post 2 signs warning MBTA Commuter Parking is Prohibited – Police Take Notice.

NEW BUSINESS:

Request for Street Lights in the Neighborhood of Garden Road Committee VOTED to recommend to Board of Selectmen for safety reasons install light provided there is an existing pole.

Request for pedestrian accommodations to access sidewalk on east side of road in the area of 12 Speen Street. TABLE DPW will evaluate area and make recommendations of options.

Request for additional light on utility pole in front of 14 Shattuck Street TABLE DPW to prepare guidance range of lumens, will review policies and practices of other communities.

Request for a sign to alert motorists on Woodland Street that steep hill leading onto Union Street is hazardous in winter months. Committee VOTED to recommend to Board of Selectmen to install Advance Warning Signage on Woodland Street to notify motorists of Stop ahead.

Davis Brook Drive residents requesting Safety Committee address speed calming measures for the neighborhood. This spring NPD to conduct speed study on both Davis Brook and Farm Hill to identify times and locations and will report back to Committee findings of the Study. TABLE pending results of speed study.

Request from Developer for an address change from 22 Wedgewood Road to 20 Spring Valley Road Committee VOTED to recommend to Board of Selectmen to hold a Public Meeting to change address from 22 Wedgewood Road to 20 Spring Valley Road.
