IMPORTANT VOTING INFORMATION

The last day to register to vote for the Tuesday, September 14, 2010 State primary election is Wednesday, August 25, 2010. In accordance with the Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 51, Section 26 the Town Clerk's office will remain open from 8 AM- 8 PM on Wednesday, August 25th.

Absentee ballots for the primary will be available beginning Monday, August 9, 2010. Absentee applications must be received no later than noon on Monday, September 13, 2010. A voter may vote absentee if he/she will be absent from Natick on election day, if a physical disability prevents him/her from voting at the polling place, or for religious beliefs which prevent the voter from voting on elect day. Absentee ballot application can be completed by the voter or a family member and are available at the Town Clerk's Office or by going on-line to <http://www.sec.state.ma.us/ele/eleifv/howabs.htm>.

POLLING LOCATION CHANGE

Voters in Precinct 8 who usually vote at Natick High School will be voting at the Morse Institute Library. The high school facility is under construction and will not be able to accommodate a polling location. The polls will be open the same hours from 7 AM – 8 PM.
