OLD BUSINESS:

Approval of the November 29, 2011 Safety Committee Minutes

Citizen Request for Street Lights on Mill Street No lights between 182 and 185 Mill and area is extremely dark. Requesting lamps be placed on every electric pole.

Republic ITS to exchange existing bulbs. Committee agreed to TABLE pending further investigation – Republic ITS to confirm address of pole locations.

Boden Lane Community Group - Update

Citizens Request: Delay in Traffic Light at intersection Superior Drive, Speen Street and Prime Parkway to allow traffic from Superior Drive. TABLED be part of the FedEx study.

Traffic Rules & Regulations: Update on Traffic Rules and Orders Draft

Pleasant Street(s)/Lincoln Street(s): Chief Hicks to check with Martha White as to what action the Safety Committee needs to take.

NEW BUSINESS:

Natick Center Associates Request for a street light on Pond Street between corner of Pond and South Main Street. (Attachment 1)

Citizens Concern of Towns Use of Yellow Parallel bars within Crosswalks and the MUTCD Guidelines (Attachment 2)

Citizens Request for “Dead End” sign be posted at bottom of Carver Hill. Also would like to request a Bailey Hill sign be posted under the Badger Ave sign already in existence. Citizen would like to further clarify whether proper name is Carver Hill Road or Carver Hill Lane their deed refers to both. (Attachment 3)

Citizens Request that the Natick Police Department enforce overnight parking on Tyler and Jackson Street. Parking has become a safety issue as emergency vehicles unable to access due to on street parking. (Attachment 4)

Citizens Request to erect a street lamp on existing telephone pole on Mechanic Street (area of 50 North Main) this street is extremely dark. (Attachment 5)

Citizens request for Change of Address at Intersection of South and Eliot Streets

Revisit Citizens Concern of Resident of 3 Fairbanks Place. Astrid Dretler originally requested of the committee for a double sided in street permanent pedestrian crosswalk sign be erected. Committee voted (June 28, 2011) not to approve as written. Ms. Dretler would like to re-address the committee as speed of vehicles and location of crosswalk is a safety issue.

Resident 13 High Street requests a "Lighted Pedestrian Crossing" sign be erected at the Pond/High Street pedestrian crossing.

Center Street resident requesting a second means of egress for emergency purposes only out of Center Street. Neighborhood had previously submitted plans to the DPW.
