Citizen Request to address Safety Issues on corner of Massachusetts and Connecticut Aves:

It is difficult to turn left onto Connecticut from Mass Ave due to the following:

1. Double Utility Pole
2. Verizon yellow box 2 ½ feet from new pole obstructing view
3. Overgrown trees and branches on town property
4. Difficult to see STOP sign due to branches on Mass Ave

Safety Committee does not have control of double poles or the Verizon box. Are the concerned overgrown trees towns property or homeowners? Tom Hladick will look into. Committee VOTED to TAKE NO ACTION will refer to DPW.

Citizen Request for Street Lights on Mill Street No lights between 182 and 185 Mill and area is extremely dark. Requesting lamps be placed on every electric pole.

Suggested we ask Wilmington Wire to look into changing existing bulbs at 182 and 185 Mill Street. Committee agreed to TABLE pending further investigation – Wilmington Wires availability in changing bulbs.
