How to Register!

Registration for Camp Woodtrail is ONLINE. Please log-in to your Community Pass account through the Recreation & Parks website. A link can be found at www.natickma.gov/recreation. After registration is complete and full payment is made, you will receive an email from CampDocs.com within a week. You will need to log-into your CampDocs account and complete your registration by filling out the profile and uploading your proof of Physical and Immunization Record. Participants who do not complete their profile and upload all documents by June 1st will be subject to a \$20 fee. Registrations after May 15 will have up to 2 weeks or the start of camp (which ever comes first) to finalize CampDocs or a \$20 fee will be assessed. All Participants must have CampDocs finalized before they can attend the program per Massachusetts Law.

- ◆ Financial aid and payment plan requests must be requested prior to registering. Please call 508-647-6530 to set-up your account before registering online.
- ◆ Assistance in uploading documents or completing your CampDocs profile is available at the Cole Center. The Cole Center is open by appointment only at this time. 508-647-6530.

- ◆ Registration can not be completed over the phone.

Natick Recreation & Parks Department has authorized the following special refund policy for Woodtrail Camp:

- All Cancellation refunds are subject to a \$10 processing fee in addition to any cancellation fees.
- Refunds by April 23: Full Price Refund
- Refunds by May 30 : Half Price refund
- No Refunds will be granted after May 30.
- For individuals receiving financial assistance, refunds will be adjusted accordingly.

If the Town of Natick decides at a later time it is unsafe to proceed with camp and the programs are cancelled, there will be no penalty to your registration fees.
