- **ANYONE REGISTERING CHILDREN FOR SWIM CLASSES, MUST PURCHASE/RENEW SEASON BEACH PASSES PRIOR TO FIRST CLASS!!**
- Registration for Session 1 will take place on **ONLINE beginning Monday June 13 at 12:00 noon.** Anyone/everyone entering the beach needs a season pass or needs to pay for a one-day pass.

- Swim Lessons are held every day Monday - Friday, (weather permitting).
- Lessons begin at 12:10 pm but the water is open to the public Monday - Friday • 12:00 - 7:00 pm.
- Lessons are 30 minutes long. (Pre-School classes are only 20 minutes).
- **Child must have turned 3 to participate in Pre-School level classes** (these are non certificate classes)
- **Session 1** • \$41 • 2 weeks • June 27 – July 8 (9 days)
- **Session 2** • \$45 • 2 weeks • July 11 – 22
- **Session 3** • \$45 • 2 weeks • July 25 – August 5
- We reserve the right to switch instructors or change/cancel classes if we feel it is necessary.
- Anyone 2 years old (before July 1, 2022) and older will need to purchase a season beach pass to enter the beach. Any child under 2, based on the above, date is free.
- Any child under the age of 10 will not be allowed into the Beach without responsible adult supervision.
