Welcome to the CRT, a 3.7-mile shared use path from Mechanic Street and Whitney Field/Navy Yard in Natick Center to Saxonville in Framingham.

Parking is in Natick at the 11 Mechanic Street lot (open Fall 2022); at the end of Chrysler Road; at the Natick Mall; in municipal lots and on-street in Natick Center; and in Framingham at 81 Speen Street.

Be alert at street crossings! At unsignalized crossings, pedestrians have the right of way. Cyclists should dismount or proceed to cross only when safe.

The CRT is part of a network. Here's what's coming:

- The CRT will extend to the Natick Center outbound platform when the new MBTA rail station is finished, scheduled for 2024. Until then, the right-of-way from Mechanic Street to the station is closed to the public for safety.
- The Town of Natick is designing a connection to Main Street in Natick Center (construction TBA).
- MassDOT is designing a path along Route 9 to Hartford and Speen Streets in West Natick; construction is scheduled to begin in 2025.
