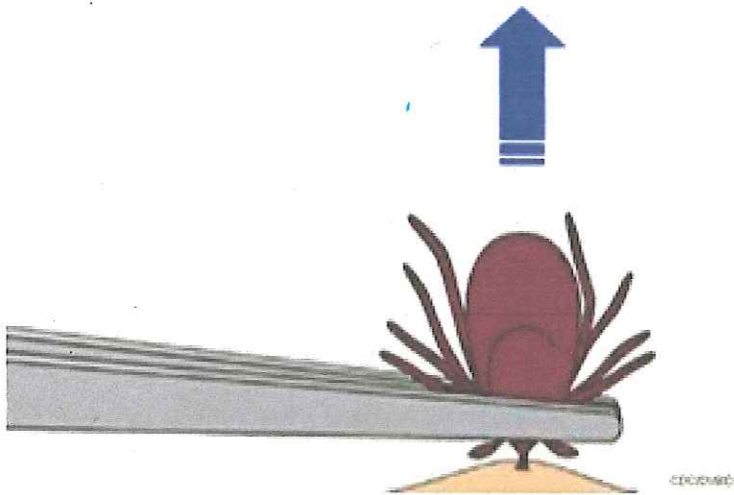


Tick Removal

- Use a fine tipped tweezers to grasp tick and pull up with steady pressure. Don't use a twisting motion.
- If mouth parts remain behind, leave alone, do not try to dig out. Wash the area with soap and water.
- If you develop a rash around the area or signs of infection- seek medical attention
