Roll Out Cart Dos & Don'ts

DO

- Follow all instructions for cart use.
- Place the cart at the curb by 7:00 AM on your collection day.
- Close lid before moving the cart.
- Keep fingers and hands clear of cart when closing.
- Clean out cart periodically with water.
- Fill cart only when cart is in an upright position.

DON'T

- Play in the cart.
- Overfill the cart – make sure lid closes completely.
- Put hot items in the cart.
- Put hazardous waste, paint cans, solvent
- Put dead animals in the cart.
- Move or tilt cart with lid open.
- Sit or stand on top of the lid or cart body.
- Deface the cart in any way.
