YARD WASTE PICK UP

SPRING: the first two full weeks in May on your trash day

FALL: (based on your trash day)

Tuesday Trash Day: Monday, Nov 5

Wednesday Trash Day: Monday, Nov 12

Thursday Trash Day: Monday, Nov 19

Friday Trash Day: Monday, Nov 26

CHRISTMAS TREES (BARE ONLY, NO BAG): the first two full weeks in January on your trash day

Yard waste (except for Christmas trees) must be in paper bags or marked rubbish barrels. **PLASTIC BAGS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED**

BULKY WASTE

If it won't fit in a Pay-As-You-Throw bag, it's a bulky item.

Bulky waste pick-ups are available for a fee every Monday (except for Monday holidays and Fall Yard Waste Mondays).

Payment must be made at the DPW on or before the Thursday prior to the Monday pick-up no later than 3 PM.

Note, prices vary by item and many items are not accepted.

2018-19 CURBSIDE COLLECTION CALENDAR



All trash and recycling must be placed curbside by 7AM. Recycling bins must be placed curbside with the open end facing out for automated pick-up or it will not be picked up. Call 508-647-6562 to determine your bin color. No recycling, bulky waste, or trash is collected on holidays. Monday holidays will not affect your regular trash day.

*Please note the DPW Main Office will be closed Monday, November 12th in observance of Veteran's Day, however yard waste collection will not be affected.

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

MATERIAL	WHAT TO RECYCLE	HOW TO PREPARE	DO NOT INCLUDE
	PAPER Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, office paper, phone books, & paperback books	Put in recycling bin	NO plastic grocery or trash bags NO soiled paper
	GLASS Bottles & jars (clear, green & brown containers only)	Rinse clean and drain Labels may be left on Do not bag	NO broken glass NO light bulbs NO other glass items (window glass, Pyrex, ceramics)
	METAL Steel & tin food/beverage cans, caps & lids Aluminum foil, pie pans and trays	Rinse clean and drain Labels may be left on Do not bag	NO paint NO aerosol cans NO other metal items
	PLASTIC Plastic bottles #1 - 7 plastic containers	Rinse clean and drain Flatten Do not bag	NO plastic bags or wrap NO motor oil containers NO Styrofoam
	CARDBOARD Corrugated, chipboard (cereal boxes, shoe boxes, clean pizza boxes) & milk or juice cartons	Flatten & cut to fit in recycling bin	NO soiled pizza/food boxes

HOUSEHOLD GOODS RECYCLING



NATICK residents can recycle unwanted clothing, shoes and home goods with free, curbside pick-up on their recycling day. Acceptable items: Clothing, shoes, accessories, home goods such as kitchenware, books, toys, etc. Visit SimpleRecycling.com for a comprehensive list of acceptable items. Yard Waste	Thermometers & Thermostats	Cardboard & Paper
Paint & Mattresses	Books	Rigid Plastics & Metal Items
Batteries	Shoes & Used Clothing	Styrofoam

PAINT SWAP SHED

Open during regular Recycling Center hours from April 1st through October 31st.

Accepts latex & oil-based paints **ONLY**, up to 5 gallons per resident.

Stains and thinners are **NOT ALLOWED**.

Usable leftover paint is available to residents.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

The Recycling Center **CANNOT** accept Hazardous Waste. Materials should be taken to the annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day.

Contact the Board of Health at 508-647-6460 for the next collection date.

PLEASE BE COURTEOUS



Recycling totes need to be 3 feet from objects including additional totes. Please ensure totes are 5 feet from vehicles.
