## NOTIFICATION EAST CENTRAL & BACON STREET WATER PIPE LINING PROJECT

Dear Project Abutter:

The Town of Natick, Department of Public Works is notifying you of the upcoming construction project in East Central Street. The Town of Natick has contracted with W. Walsh Company (Contractor), 32 Walton Street, Attleboro, MA 02703, to rehabilitate water pipes through lining along East Central Street.

The project includes lining approximately 3,800 linear feet of water pipe in East Central Street from University Drive to the Bacon Street Railroad Bridge (Wellesley) and lining approximately 5,600 linear feet of water pipe in Bacon Street from East Central to House 28 Bacon Street. The Contract drawings can be viewed on-line at the Natick website ([natickma.org](http://natickma.org)) or a paper copy at the Natick Department of Public Works.

The project will require the installation of temporary aboveground water mains with temporary water services to each building to allow existing water mains to be removed from service and the required work completed. The Contractor will be contacting each building owner to coordinate the connection of the temporary water service to your building. There may be a short duration (15 minutes or less) water shut off to make the temporary connection to your building.

The Contractor is planning on mobilizing next week to start installing the temporary by-pass piping. Anticipated work hours are 7:30 am to 4:30 pm Monday thru Friday. The water pipe work is anticipated to proceed until the beginning of August 2019. Final paving restoration will be completed in the Spring of 2020.

We realize our water main lining project may cause some inconvenience for those who live and work in the area. We are working closely with the Natick Police Department to minimize the traffic disruptions and we will do our best to see that the construction goes smoothly.

The Town has contracted with Haley and Ward, Inc to provide project oversight during construction. Haley and Ward, Inc will send out weekly project updates, via emails, and the Town will place updated information on their website.
