## Program Goals

- ◆ Assist senior citizens and veterans with property tax bills
- ◆ Increase involvement of older citizens and veterans in municipal government
- ◆ Acknowledge and affirm the skills of Natick senior citizens and veterans and the community's continuing need for their services

## Selection Process

- ◆ Must meet eligibility guidelines
- ◆ Must have appropriate skills for the position.  
Applicant **and** department head must agree it is an appropriate match
- ◆ Must complete a background (CORI) check

## Job Opportunities

- ◆ Municipal and school departments
- ◆ Types of positions available: clerical, drivers, fitness room attendant, maintenance, filing, food service, and more

## Eligibility Requirements

- ◆ 60 years or older OR
- ◆ Is a Veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces of *any* age
- ◆ Own and occupy as a primary residence the property to which taxes will be credited by July 1 of 2017
- ◆ Present a current copy of the property tax bill
- ◆ Present a copy of the 2016 income tax return
- ◆ Gross income in 2016 can not exceed amounts shown on chart
- ◆ Able to perform the functions of the job. If unable, work may be completed by a proxy worker for residents able to meet eligibility requirements but physically unable to provide the requisite services to the Town

**Applications are available May 1 - September 1, 2017**

## Eligibility Requirements, Continued

Income guidelines are shown below.

Household #	Gross Income*
1	\$43,491
2	\$56,872
3	\$70,254
4	\$82,218

\*In addition, unanticipated medical expenses will be considered as an extenuating circumstance for eligibility.

## Benefit Limits

- ◆ State minimum wage
- ◆ Maximum credit of \$1375 per household per fiscal year
- ◆ Maximum number of hours is 125 per year
- ◆ Under the law, any reduction in property taxes is considered as income for federal income tax purposes. **The Town will issue a 1099 to all participants.**
